We'll make use of technology during the conference to help you access, engage, and enjoy activities. We encourage all conference attendees to download and setup these two mobile apps prior to arriving to ensure a smooth experience:



Slack

Stay connected to the conference community and receive important announcements



Whova

Access your personal agenda and conference materials

More details about each of these three apps and how to access them are included in this guide.

Slack

We will use Slack during the conference for announcements, community messaging, and to answer your questions. We suggest you download the Slack app for convenient access during the conference. There is no cost to download or use Slack.

To set up Slack, first use the email invitation you received to join the O4UD Workspace. If you don't already have the **Slack app**, you can download it from the [App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#).

You should have already received an invitation to the O4U Digital Slack workspace. please check your spam inbox. If you still have trouble accessing the Slack workspace, please reach out to jordan.dillard@outforundergrad.org.

Whova

We will use Whova to share your personal agenda and share materials and details related to conference programming. We encourage you to set up the Whova app before arriving to help you navigate the conference. There is no cost to download or use Whova.

To set up Whova, first download the **Whova app** from the [App Store](#) or the [Google Play Store](#). The O4UD Event will be launched on October 12th, and anytime after that you can access the O4UD Event by signing in using the email address you used to register for the conference. If the app is asking you for a code, then you did not use the correct email address to sign in.

Already used the Whova app in the past? Double-check that it is installed on your phone, and log in using your existing account email and password.
